

**AFFIDAVIT FOR EXEMPTION FROM JURY SERVICE FOR
INABILITY TO COMPREHEND OR COMMUNICATE IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE**

Per Government Code Section 62.109, the judge of a district court by order may permanently or for a specified period exempt from service as a juror in all the county and district courts in the county a person with an inability to comprehend or communicate in the English language. The applicant must submit in person, an affidavit and a statement from an interpreter. A person exempt from jury service under this section may rescind the exemption at any time by filing a signed request for the rescission with the voter registrar of the county.

Note: The applicant will be notified if the request is granted or denied.
