Describe the Deviation:

On April 16, 2025, Pearland Police Department submitted evidence without any subject information. BCCL-25-0705 Exhibit 001 was requested to be tested in relation to a sexual assault investigation, Pearland PD case number 25-000642. The Laboratory typically requires subject information in order to produce a report. However, by mutual agreement between Pearland PD and the Laboratory, the evidentiary item in question will be analyzed, and an initial report generated without any subject information. Once Pearland PD identifies the subject, the agency representative will notify the Laboratory, at which time an amended report to include the newfound information will be issued.
